"If you obey the commandments of Jehovah your God, which I am commanding you today, to love Jehovah your God and walk in His ways and keep His commandments and His statutes and His judgments, then you will live and multiply, and Jehovah your God will bless you in the land which you are entering to possess." - Seek the Lord concerning migrating and joining fellowship in GTCA conferences and tours in 2020.
