Allowing the Peace, Letting the Word, and Persevering in Prayer

“Let the peace of Christ arbitrate in your hearts, to which also you were called in one Body; and be thankful.” (Col. 3:15)

“Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to God.” (Col. 3:16)

“Persevere in prayer, watching in it with thanksgiving.” (Col. 4:2)

As we are ruled by the peace of Christ and inhabited by the word of Christ through persevering in prayer, He permeates and replaces us with Himself until all our natural distinctions have been eliminated, and we become the new man in reality. (*The Goal of the Lord's Recovery*, msg. 5, IV)

Adequate and Definite Times to Absorb the Lord

We need to set aside definite times for prayer; our attitude should be that prayer is our most important business and that nothing should be allowed to interfere with it. Lord, bring each of us to establish a definite and adequate time of prayer to contact and absorb You, so that You may flow through us!
