## Monday, January 19

Pray over these key verses:

Acts 9:3-5 And as he went, he drew near to Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him. And he fell on the ground and heard a voice saying to him, Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me? And he said, Who are You, Lord? And He said, I am Jesus, whom you persecute.

## Tuesday, January 20

Pray over these key verses:

Acts 9:17-19 And Ananias went away and entered into the house; and laying his hands on him, he said, Saul, brother, the Lord has sent me — Jesus, who appeared to you on the road on which you were coming — so that you may receive your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit. And immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and he received his sight and rose up and was baptized. And once he had taken food, he was strengthened. And he was with the disciples in Damascus for some days.

## Wednesday, January 21

Pray over these key verses:

Acts 9:20, 22 And immediately he proclaimed Jesus in the synagogues, that this One is the Son of God... But Saul was all the more empowered, and he confounded the Jews dwelling in Damascus by proving that this One is the Christ.

## Thursday, January 22

Pray over these key verses:

Acts 10:1-4 Now there was in Caesarea a certain man named Cornelius, . . . devout and one who feared God with all his household, giving many alms to the people and beseeching God continually. He saw clearly in a vision around the ninth hour of the day an angel of God coming in to him . . . And he looked intently at him and became terrified and said, What is it, Lord? And he said to him, Your prayers and your alms have ascended as a memorial before God.

## Friday, January 23

Pray over these key verses:

Acts 10:44 While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those hearing the word.

Col. 2:12 Buried together with Him in baptism, in which also you were raised together with Him through the faith of the operation of God, who raised Him from the dead.

## Saturday, January 24

Pray over these key verses:

Acts 11:15-16 And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell on them just as also on us in the beginning.

John 20:22 And when He had said this, He breathed into them and said to them, Receive the Holy Spirit.
